What is feminism? Why does it still matter? What exactly does intersectionality mean?

In order to answer these (and many other) questions, *I Am a Feminist* first examines the history of feminism and then addresses the issues girls and women continue to face today. The book also looks at the ways in which people, especially young people, are working together to create a world where gender equality is a reality, not a dream. The author shares stories about the courageous individuals who have made a difference in the lives of women and girls worldwide. From suffragists to the #MeToo movement, *I Am a Feminist* encourages readers to stand up and speak out for equality and justice.

RESPONSE TO CHALLENGES

After Assistant Superintendent Kari Dendurent of Seward High School in Soldotna, Alaska, recalled 15 books including *I Am a Feminist*, the Soldotna High School Librarian Tamra Wear sent a litter to the District Superintendent condemning these actions to recall the books, and calling for "full disclosure" of the incident. Kenai Peninsula Education Association President Nathan Erfurth wrote that this fell into "a pattern of bullying and exclusion…developing in our school district." The books were returned to the school library two months later.

By recalling the books, Dendurent violated two district policies: the board's policy governing handling of "Public Complaints Concerning Instructional Materials" and their administrative rule regarding "Challenges to Instructional Materials."
